## 2<sup>nd</sup> COLLOQUIUM IN LINGUISTIC AND LITERARY STUDIES – CIELLI

### 5<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL COLLOQUIUM IN LINGUISTIC AND LITERARY STUDIES – CELLI

Data: 13-15 June 2012

The Colloquium will consist of:

- 2 Conferences: Roger Chartier (France) e Carlos Reis (Portugal)
- 6 Roundtables
- 6 Mini-courses in Linguistic and Literary Studies (lecturers will be invited by the organizing committee)
- Symposiums:
  - 15 symposiums in Linguistic Studies with a minimum of 12 participants and a maximum of 24.
  - symposiums in Literary Studies with a minimum of 12 participants and a maximum of 24.

#### INFORMATION AND NORMS ON SUBMITTING PROPOSALS FOR THE SYMPOSIUMS

Symposiums are organized and coordinated by two PhD professors from two different universities.

Symposium proposal will be available from 05<sup>th</sup> September 2011 on the homepage of the colloquium by clicking on the link "Submission of Proposals". Each symposium may be coordinated by two PhD professors from two different universities. Symposium proposals must be sent via the colloquium homepage ([www.cielli.com.br](http://www.cielli.com.br)) to the organizing committee by 30<sup>th</sup> November 2011.

The organizing committee will publish accepted proposals on the homepage by 15<sup>th</sup> December 2011. Coordinators of selected symposiums must click on the link "Enrolment" for fee payment according to rates and deadlines available for consultation. Coordinators of Symposiums will analyze proposal for papers up to 15<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and inform the definitive list of papers of their Symposium.

Symposium Coordinators deadline for fee payment: 31<sup>st</sup> January 2012.

Period for paper submission to Symposiums: from from 6<sup>th</sup> February 2012 to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2012.

Each participant may submit up to two papers (as autor or co-author) and each paper may have up to two authors.

It is the Symposium coordinators role to receive the Abstracts, give their approval or rejection (minimum 12, maximum 24), and select, analyze and revise all papers submitted for publication in the Proceedings

The Symposiums without the minimum number of participants till the deadline will be cancelled and the abstracts will be integrated by the organizing committee into other Symposiums as long as they have a similar theme to the theme indicated by the author. Analysis of abstracts (approval or rejection) will be done exclusively by the coordinators of the Symposiums through the Colloquium homepage. List of accepted papers of each symposium will be published by 20<sup>th</sup> May 2012.

Undergraduate students may not submit abstracts to symposiums. However, undergraduate students who integrate projects (Teaching, Research, Extension) may submit an abstract to an oral communication session with the indication of the name of the professor-adviser.

### **SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE OF 2<sup>nd</sup> CIELLI**

Scientific committee will be composed by members of the organizing committee and by the coordinators of the symposiums.

### **PUBLICATION OF PAPERS**

- The organizing committee will publish the presented papers as Proceedings up to three months after the Colloquium.
- Participants who wish to have their papers published must send the file with the complete text of their papers up to seven days after the end of the Colloquium.
- The symposium coordinator may suggest corrections to the texts. Up to thirty days after the end of the Colloquium texts must be ready.
- Papers of undergraduate students will be published as expanded abstracts (4 pages).

### **NORMS FOR PROPOSAL OF SYMPOSIUMS (ONLY FOR COORDINATORS)**

**The abstract of the symposium proposal must have:**

- a) Title.
- b) Name of the coordinators, degree, university, CPF.
- c) Abstract with 3000- 4000 characters (with spaces).
- d) Keywords: 3 (three).

### **NORMS FOR PROPOSAL OF ABSTRACTS BY THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE SYMPOSIUMS**

**The abstract papers submitted to symposiums must have:**

- a) Title.
- b) Name of the author(s), university, CPF.
- c) Abstract with 1000- 1700 characters (with spaces).
- d) Keywords: 3 (three).

Undergraduate students may not submit abstracts to symposiums.

### **NORMS FOR PROPOSAL OF ABSTRACTS BY UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS WHO INTEGRATE PROJECTS (ORAL COMMUNICATION SESSIONS)**

**The abstract for an oral communication session must have:**

- a) Title.
- b) Name of the author(s), university, CPF.
- c) Abstract with 1000- 1700 characters (with spaces).
- d) Keywords: 3 (three).

Undergraduate students may not submit abstracts to symposiums.

### **FEES**

- Symposium coordinators = R\$ 100,00;
- Undergraduate students with oral communication = R\$ 60,00;
- Undergraduate students without oral communication = R\$ 40,00;
- Postgraduation students without oral communication = R\$ 80,00;

- Postgraduation students with oral communication = R\$ 100,00;
- Other participants without oral communication = R\$ 100,00;
- Other participants with oral communication = R\$ 120,00;
- Enrolment fee for mini-courses = R\$ 15,00.
